**Scholarship Information**

The Hilliard Girls Softball Association (hGsa) is awarding a \$1,000 scholarship to up to three graduating seniors from each of the three Hilliard High Schools. Past graduates of the Hilliard School District presently attending college are also eligible.

The scholarship is in memory of Harold Lawson, a long time hGsa softball coach. A committee of persons selected by the HGSA Board of Directors will determine the winners of the scholarships. The recipients will be chosen based on the selection criteria. Applications may be picked up at the Guidance office of Darby, Davidson, and Bradley High Schools.

**Selection Criteria**

- Must have participated in the hGsa’s summer league program. Participation may have been as a player, coach, or umpire.
- Must have a high school G.P.A. of at least 2.75 with verification provided by the school.
- Must submit an essay of a minimum of 1,000 words describing your greatest softball memory.
- The scholarship checks will be made payable directly to the recipient upon receipt of proof of college enrollment.
- Applications can be mailed to P.O. Box 707, Hilliard, Ohio 43026 and must be received no later than March 31, 2025, as the scholarships will be presented at each high school’s Senior Awards Banquet. On the envelope, please indicate Harold Lawson Scholarship.
